Career Educational Pathway Diesel Technician/Emergency Vehicle Manufacturing

Description

Introduces the diesel shop environment, and emphasizes shop safety and general shop practices. Introduces over-the-road commercial motor vehicle preventative maintenance, and prepares students for success in the core diesel program classes.

Entrance criteria: Reading assessment or equivalent background/knowledge required.

Who Should be in this Program

Begin your career in the high-demand diesel industry with the Diesel Technology Assistant Certificate. Through training in our hands-on lab, you'll learn how to assist installation, maintenance and repair workers. Gain the skills needed to maintain and repair vehicles, industrial machinery, and electrical and electronic equipment. Candidates interested in emergency vehicle assembly, working for companies such as Pierce Manufacturing, or commercial truck maintenance and repair at companies such as Masterfleet, should pursue this career path. FVTC and Goodwill can assist with employer connections at the onset of the technical training.
