- Safety: Machine safety, PPE, ergonomics, and forklift truck awareness
- Hand Tools: Safety, working on a hand tool trainer, torque wrenches and metric vs. standard
- Sensors: Introduction to and retroreflective optical sensing lab
- Forklift: Education and certification
