Description

Prepares learners for roles as professional caregivers, providing essential skills to support clients across a variety of settings, including home care, skilled nursing facilities, hospitals, and assisted living. This course covers a broad range of personal care fundamentals and interpersonal skills, with a focus on client dignity, safety, and health support. By the end of the course, students will understand the duties and responsibilities, including effective communication, client-centered care, and the importance of maintaining confidentiality and professionalism.

Who Should be in this Program

In addition to empathy and compassion, individuals who have a desire to help others, effective communication and observation skills. Other important characteristics of a patient care technician are: attention to detail, flexibility, emotional stability, and determination.
